

Build envelope – Retail store fixtures

Gondola uprights, shelves, back panels and refrigeration carcasses – pressed, folded, welded, coated and packed at volume, to your drawing, in your finish.

What we are tooled for

	Wall bay	perimeter runs, back panels, single-sided.
	Island gondola	double-sided, higher load path, the volume workhorse.
	Chilled carcass	the fabricated body, door frame and finish for refrigerated display.

These are envelopes, not products. You draw the system; we tool for it.

Build envelope

Sheet	1–15 mm
Bending	CNC press brakes, 80–130 tons. Tooling radius 0.6–50 mm
Panel bending	enclosure parts up to 2.5 mm
Rolling	NC four-roll, cylindrical and curved
Materials	carbon steel and stainless (about 90%); aluminium (about 10%)
Finish	powder coating in-house, any colour and texture. Galvanizing and KTL through certified partners
Series	200–10,000 a year, from batches of ten

The numbers, before you ask

4 weeks From order to delivery. Series production, no special requirement.	10 pieces Minimum order.	200 a year Minimum annual volume to keep your tooling live.	6–8 weeks Validated first article, with a measurement report.
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Tooling appears as a separate line in every quote. You always see what the changeover costs, and what it buys.
